

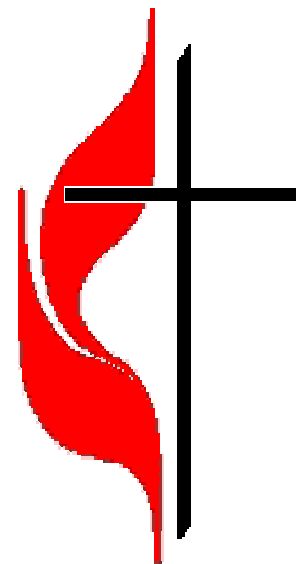

**Please prayerfully consider giving to the Ministries Fund plus either the Landiss Lectures or Jubilee Building Fund.**

**Ministries Fund** – annual goal is \$50,000 from approximately 100 Alumni & Friends to support our ongoing ministries (suggested gift of \$150 to \$1,500).

**Landiss Lectures Fund** – annual goal is \$5,000 for the "Asking the Value Question" guest lecture series (suggested gift of \$50 to \$100).

**Jubilee Building Fund** – \$300,000 is needed to finish the "Jubilee Project" building and grounds renovation. Two major donations (with naming rights) are being sought from families or charitable foundations --- \$100K for the entire kitchen re-do and \$75K to replace all windows and doors throughout the building with high energy-efficient glass. \$125K is needed for the rest (suggested gift of \$1,000 to \$5,000).
